### What to expect during your recovery

## What to do if you have **pain** as a result of your procedure:

Some ways to control pain include prescription medicine, over-the-counter pain relievers as advised by your doctor, or heat / ice packs.

Notify the Doctor if you have severe abdominal or chest pain.

#### What to do if you have nausea or vomiting:

Stay hydrated with small sips of clear liquids, avoid spicy or rich foods, try a bland diet (saltine crackers or plain bread), try eating a small meal before returning to a regular diet.

Notify the Doctor if you have persistent nausea, vomiting or vomiting with blood



# What to do if you have **bleeding** as a result of your procedure:

Notify the Doctor if you pass more than 2-3 tablespoons of blood by rectum

#### What to do if you have possible signs of infection:

Possible signs of infection include fever, swelling, heat, drainage or redness.

Notify the Doctor if you notice chills and/or fever over 101 or IV site becomes infected or is painful
